Dec 8 Public Hearing held to discuss proposed design changes to US 181 Harbor Bridge Project

Several residents attended a Public Hearing held at City Hall in December to discuss proposed design changes to the Harbor Bridge Project, specifically addressing property right-of-way within the boundaries of T.C. Ayers Park. During the hearing, proposed design modifications, potential park impacts and proposed mitigation options were reviewed with the public. Meeting attendees had the opportunity to provide public comment regarding the proposed changes. Under the Recommended Alternative, as presented in the January 2016 Record of Decision for US 181 Harbor Bridge Project, 5.36 acres of right-of-way was approved for use of T.C. Ayers park property. The proposed design modifications presented at the December 8 Public Hearing, outlined the requirements to use an additional 1.0 acre net increase in the amount of right-of-way required from the park property.
