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Upcoming Harbor Bridge Project nightly ramp closures to affect IH 37 and SH 286 (Crosstown Expressway)

CORPUS CHRISTI – Various ramp closures affecting traffic traveling within the IH 37/SH 286 interchange will take place over night on Friday, May 31, 2019. All closures will take place from 9 p.m. to 6 a.m. as part of the Harbor Bridge Project. The closures are necessary to set barrier along southbound SH 286 (Crosstown Expressway). All work is weather permitting. A detailed listing of closures is included below.

Short-Term Ramp Closures

Beginning Friday, May 31, 2019, between 9 p.m. and 6 a.m. the following ramp closures will be in effect. The IH 37 direct connectors will not be closed concurrently.

- The southbound IH 37 direct connector to southbound SH 286 will be closed. Motorists needing to access southbound SH 286 in this area will need to utilize the Port Avenue exit ramp.
- The northbound IH 37 direct connector to southbound SH 286 will be closed. Motorists needing to access southbound SH 286 in this area will need to utilize the U-turn at Up River Road exit.
- The southbound SH 286 entrance ramp from Leopard Street will be closed. Motorists needing to access southbound SH 286 in this area will need to utilize the Comanche Street entrance ramp.

Motorists are urged to be aware of the lane closures, to consider using alternate routes, to follow all traffic control devices, and to slow down in the work zones.
