Upcoming Harbor Bridge Project lane closures to affect IH 37 near Alameda Pedestrian Bridge

Closures necessary to remove the existing bridge

CORPUS CHRISTI – The main lanes on IH 37 will be closed nightly between Tanchua Street and SH 286 (Crosstown Expressway) beginning Friday, November 1, 2019 to Monday, November 4, 2019 as part of the Harbor Bridge Project. This is a full freeway closure. The closures will take place each night beginning at 9 p.m. and ending at 6 a.m. and are necessary to remove the existing bridge. All work is weather permitting. Details of the closures are listed below.

November 1, 2019

Southbound IH 37 will be closed to through traffic. Northbound IH 37 through traffic will be reduced to one lane.

November 2-4, 2019

Northbound IH 37 will be closed to through traffic. Southbound IH 37 through traffic will be reduced to one lane.

During the demolition process, downtown access for northbound IH 37 will still be available via Leopard Street.

Commercial truck traffic traveling the Harbor Bridge during this time period is encouraged to utilize the Joe Fulton Corridor as an alternate route.

Motorists are urged to be aware of the lane closures, to consider using alternate routes to avoid delay, to follow all traffic control devices, and to slow down in the work zones.
