Upcoming Harbor Bridge Project long-term closure to affect Port Avenue between Antelope Street (IH 37 eastbound frontage road) and Leopard Street

Long-term closure to be in effect beginning Monday, May 24, 2021

CORPUS CHRISTI – Beginning May 24, Port Avenue between Antelope Street (IH 37 eastbound frontage road) and Leopard Street will be closed through June 14. The long-term closure is necessary for utility work related to the Harbor Bridge Project.

Motorists heading southbound on Port Avenue will be detoured onto Martin Luther King Drive and follow the detour signs to Nueces Bay Boulevard and Leopard Street. Motorists heading northbound on Port Avenue will be detoured onto Leopard Street and follow the signs to Nueces Bay Boulevard and Antelope Street. See attached detour map, which includes a route for pedestrians.

Portable message signs will be in place to assist motorists with navigating the alternate routes. Business driveways along the closed section of Port Avenue will be granted access for customers and employees.

Motorists are urged to be aware of the closure, consider using alternate routes, follow all traffic control devices, and to slow down in the work zones. All work is weather permitting.

Harbor Bridge Project Port Avenue/Antelope Street Intersection Detour

Pedestrian Detour
Pedestrians traveling Northbound and Southbound on Port Avenue will have access to the sidewalk under IH37 and will be able to travel on Port Avenue.

Traffic traveling Southbound on Port Avenue will be detoured right onto Martin Luther King Drive (WBFRN). Directed left onto Nueces Bay Blvd, then directed left onto Leopard Street, from there Traffic may stay straight onto Leopard Street, then right back onto Southbound Port Avenue.

Traffic traveling Northbound on Port Avenue will be detoured left onto Leopard Street, right turn onto Nueces Bay and back on Antelope Street (EBFRN), where traffic will take a left back onto Northbound Port Avenue.

Traffic will be converted to One-Way Only Northbound Traffic underneath IH37/Port Avenue Bridge.

Port Avenue between Antelope Street (EBFRN) and Leopard Street will be Closed to Thru Traffic.
Business Driveways will be left open for access.
