



SCOPE OF WORK

This solicitation addresses the need for sheet pile material for the US 181 Harbor Bridge Project in Corpus Christi, Texas

1.0 SCOPE OF WORK

This Scope of Work includes supply and delivery of three hundred fifty linear feet (350lf) of thirty feet (30') in length of sheet piles that meets the following requirements:

- All steel shall be new, reused material is not accepted in the performance of this Scope.
- Domestic Steel that meets Buy America Requirements including Material Certifications.
- Type(s) Acceptable (by Supplier):
 - ZZ14 or better
 - NZ14 or better
 - PZ27 or better
 - AZ17 or better
 - PZC17 or better
 - Meets minimum of 180 in⁴/ft of wall
- Eight (8) Corner Pieces for supplied shape

Scope of work excludes the following any drawings or designing of Sheet Piles.

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3.0 GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

Seller's construction safe work practices, and job procedures are to conform to the following standards: Occupational Safety & Health Regulations (OSHA), Texas Department of Transportation "Standard Specification for Construction and Maintenance of Highway, Streets, and Bridges", Port of Corpus Christi and Contractor's health safety policies and standards.

Seller shall assume toward the Buyer all obligations and responsibilities which the Contractor has assumed toward the Owner under the Contract to the extent such obligations and liabilities relate to the Seller's Work. In case of conflict between the terms of this Purchase Order Agreement and Contract, the Purchase Order Agreement shall control. - Services will be provided in the city of Corpus Christi, Texas within the Port. Subcontractor must follow Port of Corpus Christi rules.
- Seller shall communicate and coordinate all aspects of its works with the Contractor's Authorized Representative.
- Seller shall be responsible for all deliveries to and from the working location defined by the Contractor's Authorized Representative.
- Seller shall comply with Contractor's safety plan and procedures and forms at all times.
- Seller shall comply with the use of required Personal Protective Equipment (PPE)
