Upcoming Harbor Bridge Project temporary connector ramp closure to affect southbound I-37 to southbound SH 286. A southbound I-37 mainlane reduction from Nueces Bay Boulevard to the South Interchange will also be in place. Motorists should plan accordingly.

Temporary one-night ramp closure and mainlane reduction to be in effect June 12, 2025.

CORPUS CHRISTI – On Thursday, June 12, from 9 pm until 6 am, the exit ramp from southbound I-37 to southbound SH 286 will be closed and southbound I-37 will be reduced to two lanes from Nueces Bay Boulevard to the South Interchange. The ramp closure and mainlane reduction is necessary for overhead sign installation.

Motorists heading to SH 286 from I-37 should seek an alternate route. Portable message signs will be in place along southbound I-37 to alert commuters of the temporary ramp closure, mainlane reduction, and potential traffic delays.

Motorists are urged to be aware of slow-rolling traffic, plan for an alternate route, follow all traffic control devices, and to slow down in the work zones. All work is weather permitting.
