Harbor Bridge Project announces the opening of the Burleson Street Intersection and East Causeway Boulevard on North Beach.

Burleson Street beneath the new Harbor Bridge on North Beach, and the full northbound US 181 frontage road will open today, January 16.

CORPUS CHRISTI – Beginning this afternoon, January 16, commuters in the North Beach area will have improved access with Burleson Street opening as a two-way through street. In addition, the newly constructed US 181 northbound frontage road (E Causeway Blvd) will open to two lanes with full access to city streets from Bridgeport to Beach Avenue. Additional improvements include new sidewalks and drainage systems along the frontage road.

Commuters should plan accordingly for enhanced connectivity as the Harbor Bridge Project advances toward the final US 181 alignment along North Beach.

Demolition activities to remove the old Harbor Bridge approach structures from the Corpus Christi Ship Channel to Burleson Avenue will continue through Spring 2026.

Motorists are urged to be aware of the new Burleson Street route, follow new signage and all traffic control devices, and to slow down in the work zones. All work is weather permitting.
