Upcoming Harbor Bridge Project long-term closure to affect Padre Street from Belden Street to N Carancahua Street. Commuters in the area can utilize W Broadway, Sam Rankin, Brewster, and N Tanchua Streets as a two-way detour.

Long-term closure to be in effect from January to March 2026.

CORPUS CHRISTI – Beginning Wednesday, January 28, through mid-March, Padre Street will be closed from Belden Street to N Carancahua Street. The long-term closure is necessary to continue the realignment and restoration as demolition of the old Harbor Bridge progresses.

Detour signs will be in place directing motorists to utilize W Broadway, Sam Rankin, Brewster, and N Tanchua Streets for access to the areas impacted by the Padre Street closure.

N Carancahua Street commuters must turn left on Padre Street.

Belden Street commuters must turn right on N Tanchua Street.

Motorists are urged to be aware of the long-term, consider using alternate routes, follow all traffic control devices, and to slow down in the work zones. All work is weather permitting.
