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Upcoming Harbor Bridge Project 48-hour closure will affect the N Brownlee Blvd US 181 northbound frontage road beneath IH 37. A detour will be in place.

Two-day N Brownlee Blvd frontage road closure to be in effect March 18 – 20.

CORPUS CHRISTI – Beginning tomorrow, Wednesday, March 18, at 9 am, the N Brownlee Blvd US 181 northbound frontage road will be closed beneath IH 37 for up to 48 hours. The two-day closure is necessary for emergency repairs to damaged barrier rail.

Commuters leaving the Uptown Area toward northbound US 181 will be detoured as follows: N Brownlee Blvd → Antelope Steet, turn left on Staples Street, turn left on Martin Luther King Drive Blvd, take the U-turn at Nueces Bay Blvd, and merge onto IH 37 for the direct connector to northbound US 181.

Traffic merging onto northbound US 181 from northbound IH 37 will not be impacted. A police unit will be in place at the N Brownlee Blvd intersection to assist with traffic flow.

Motorists are urged to seek an alternate route, follow all traffic control devices, and to slow down in the work zones. All work is weather permitting.
