Upcoming Harbor Bridge Project temporary one-night full southbound IH 37 mainlane closure, followed by long-term ramp closures, will affect northbound SH 286 and southbound US 181 commuters connecting to IH 37 toward the Bayfront/Downtown areas. Motorists should plan for alternate routes accordingly.

Long-term ramp closures will be in effect from May 30 through July 2026.

CORPUS CHRISTI – On Friday, May 29, at 9 pm until 6 am, all southbound IH 37 mainlanes will be temporarily closed from US 181 to N Chaparral Street. Message boards will be in place to assist motorists with navigating detour routes.

Beginning Saturday, May 30, through July: Southbound IH 37 entrance ramps from northbound SH 286 and southbound US 181 to the Bayfront/Downtown areas will be closed for up to eight weeks. The long-term ramp closures are necessary to continue realignment and restoration along IH 37. Message boards will be in place to assist motorists with navigating detour routes.

- **Northbound SH 286 to Southbound IH 37 Detour:** Take the connector ramp for northbound IH 37, exit immediately at Nueces Bay Blvd, and make a U-turn to access the entrance ramp for southbound IH 37.
- **Southbound US 181 to Southbound IH 37 Detour:** Take the connector ramp for northbound IH 37, exit immediately at Nueces Bay Blvd, and make a U-turn to access the entrance ramp for southbound IH 37.

Access to Staples Street and the Uptown area will remain unaffected during the long-term ramp closures.

Motorists are urged to be aware of the temporary mainlane and long-term ramp closures, plan an alternate route, follow all traffic control devices, and to slow down in the work zones. All work is weather permitting.
