Upcoming Harbor Bridge Project temporary mainlane reduction and shoulder closure to affect northbound US 181 commuters on the Harbor Bridge.

Temporary northbound US 181 mainlane reductions will be in effect at night only on June 9.

CORPUS CHRISTI – On Tuesday, June 9, from 9 pm until midnight, northbound US 181 over the Harbor Bridge will be reduced to one outside mainlane. The temporary lane and shoulder reduction are necessary to remove equipment from the south tower.

All northbound commuters on the Harbor Bridge to Portland or North Beach will merge right into a single travel lane.

Traffic control devices will be in place to alert motorists of the mainlane and shoulder closures.

Motorists are urged to be aware of the mainlane closures, prepare for delays, follow all traffic control devices, and to slow down in the work zones. All work is weather permitting.
