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**Upcoming Harbor Bridge Project long-term exit ramp closure to affect commuters traveling northbound on IH 37 leaving the Downtown and Bayfront areas toward northbound US 181 and the loop ramp for southbound SH 286. Detours will be in place during the ongoing construction to restore and realign IH 37.**

*Long-term exit ramp closure from northbound IH 37 will begin effect on July 23.*

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**CORPUS CHRISTI** – Beginning tomorrow, July 23, at 6 am, through mid-August, the exit ramp from northbound IH 37 toward northbound US 181 and the Martin Luther King Drive frontage road toward the loop ramp for southbound SH 286 will be closed for up to four weeks. The ramp closure is necessary to continue restoration and the final alignment of IH 37.

Message boards will be in place to assist commuters with the following detours during the long-term ramp closure.

Motorists leaving the Bayfront and Downtown areas heading toward northbound US 181 to Portland or southbound SH 286 to Crosstown Expressway will continue along northbound IH 37, take the Port Ave/Nueces Bay exit, make a U-turn at Nueces Bay, and merge onto southbound IH 37 to access the direct connector ramps.

**Motorists are urged to be aware of the long-term ramp closure, consider using alternate routes, follow all traffic control devices, and to slow down in the work zones. All work is weather permitting.**
