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Harbor Bridge Project announces opening of northbound IH 37 traffic lanes following a one-night temporary full northbound IH 37 closure at N Mesquite Street, which is necessary to perform the traffic switch. The opening of new and extended mainlanes will provide improved access for motorists leaving the Bayfront and Downtown areas.

Temporary northbound IH 37 closure and traffic switch will be in effect on July 22.

CORPUS CHRISTI – Today, July 22, from 9 pm until 6 am, a temporary full northbound IH 37 mainlane closure will be in place from N Mesquite Street to Staples Street. The one-night closure is necessary to switch traffic onto new traffic lanes and open northbound IH 37 to continue toward Calallen.

Message boards will be in place to assist commuters with the following detours.

Motorists leaving the Bayfront and Downtown areas will be routed toward the Martin Luther King Drive frontage road – turn right on N Chaparral Street, left on Belden Street, left on N Tanchua Street, and right onto the northbound IH 37 frontage road.

- Northbound IH 37 Detour: Continue along Martin Luther King Drive and utilize the on-ramp at Nueces Bay Boulevard.
- Northbound US 181 Detour: Continue along Martin Luther King Drive, utilize the U-turn at Nueces Bay Boulevard, and merge onto southbound IH 37 to access the direct connector ramp for northbound US 181.
- Southbound SH 286 Detour: Continue along Martin Luther King Drive to access the loop ramp for southbound SH 286.

Motorists are urged to be aware of the highway closure, consider using alternate routes, follow all traffic control devices, and to slow down in the work zones. All work is weather permitting.
