Upcoming Harbor Bridge Project temporary, one-night closures to affect commuters around the US 181, IH 37, and SH 286 South Interchange. Highway mainlanes will not be impacted by the closures. Detours will be in place along the frontage roads.

Temporary closures around the South Interchange will be in effect at night only on August 10.

CORPUS CHRISTI – On Monday, August 10, from 8 pm until 6 am, temporary closures will be in place around the US 181, IH 37, and SH 286 South Interchange. The closures are necessary to complete work on an overhead sign column.

Police flaggers and detour signs will be in place during the following temporary closures to assist with traffic flow at the Port Avenue/IH 37 and Comanche Street/SH 286 intersections.

CLOSED: Southwest Loop Ramp connecting from southbound US 181 to Antelope Street toward Staples Street and the Downtown area.

CLOSED: Antelope Street from Port Avenue to Mexico Street.

CLOSED: Northbound Port Avenue U-turn at Martin Luther King Drive.

Motorists are urged to be aware of the temporary loop ramp and partial frontage road closure, plan an alternate route, follow all traffic control devices, and to slow down in the work zones. All work is weather permitting.
