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Harbor Bridge Project temporary northbound US 181 mainlane reduction and entrance ramp closure will affect commuters at the South Interchange. A detour will be in place during the entrance ramp closure.

Temporary mainlane reductions and entrance ramp closure will be in effect August 12.

CORPUS CHRISTI – On Wednesday, August 12, from 9 pm until 6 am, northbound US 181 at the South Interchange will be reduced to one mainlane of through traffic and the northbound US 181 entrance ramp from the N Brownlee Boulevard frontage road will be temporarily closed.

Commuters leaving the Uptown Area heading toward northbound US 181 will be detoured to take Staples Street and turn left on the Martin Luther King Drive frontage road, take the U-turn at Nueces Bay Boulevard, and merge onto IH 37 for the direct connector to northbound US 181.

Traffic control devices will be in place to assist with navigating the detour routes.

Motorists are urged to be aware of the mainlane reduction and ramp closure, seek alternate routes, follow all traffic control devices, and to slow down in the work zones. All work is weather permitting.
