Upcoming Harbor Bridge Project temporary one-night full closure will affect southbound IH 37 commuters heading to the Bayfront and Downtown areas. Motorists should plan for an alternate route.

Temporary full closure will be in effect on August 19.

CORPUS CHRISTI – Tomorrow, Wednesday, August 19, from 9 pm until 2 am, all southbound IH 37 mainlanes will be temporarily closed from US 181 to N Chaparral Street.

Portable message boards and detour signs will be in place to assist motorists with navigating the following detour routes:

Motorists traveling southbound on IH 37 from the Calallen area will be detoured to take the connector ramp for southbound SH 286, exit at Morgan Avenue, and turn left to navigate toward the Bayfront and Downtown areas.

Motorists traveling southbound on US 181 from North Beach and Portland will be detoured to continue along southbound SH 286, exit at Morgan Avenue, and turn left to navigate toward the Bayfront and Downtown areas.

Motorists traveling northbound on SH 286 will be detoured to take the Agnes/Laredo Street exit to navigate toward the Bayfront and Downtown areas.

Access to Staples Street and the Uptown area will remain unaffected the during temporary mainlane closure.

Motorists are urged to be aware of the full southbound closure, plan an alternate route, follow all traffic control devices, and to slow down in the work zones. All work is weather permitting.
