Harbor Bridge Project: Martin Luther King Drive and Northwest Loop Ramp ongoing closure will affect commuters along the frontage road from Sam Rankin to Coke Street for up to six consecutive days. Detours will be in place.

Long-term frontage road and loop ramp closure will continue August 25 – September 1.

CORPUS CHRISTI – Continuing today, Tuesday, August 25, through Tuesday, September 1, Martin Luther King Drive and the Northwest Loop Ramp to southbound SH 286 will remain closed along the northbound IH 37 frontage road from Sam Rankin to Coke Street.

Portable message boards and detour signs will be in place to direct motorists as follows:

Northbound IH 37 commuters heading toward southbound SH 286 should exit at Port Ave/Nueces Bay Blvd and continue along the frontage road to take the U-turn at Nueces Bay Boulevard, and merge onto southbound IH 37 to access the connector ramp for southbound SH 286.

Martin Luther King Drive commuters will be detoured to turn right on Sam Rankin Street, left on Winnebago Street, right on N Brownlee Boulevard, and left on Lake Street* to access Martin Luther King Drive.

***OVERSIZED VEHICLES** must be aware of a lower (14' 9") clearance at Lake Street beneath the US 181 approach bridge.

Motorists are urged to be aware of potential delays, consider using alternate routes, follow all traffic control devices, and to slow down in the work zones. All work is weather permitting.
